

2024 NUTRIEN CLASSIC

NUTRIEN CLASSIC CAMPDRAFT TERMS & CONDITIONS - \$110.00

1. Nutrien Classic Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained by accessing links on the Nutrien Equine website.
2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
3. Horses are not eligible if they are not transferred into the purchaser's name. This is mandatory.
4. Entries must be completed by owners wishing to enter horses in the Nutrien Classic Campdraft.
5. Horses and owners will only be eligible for the prizemoney that attaches to the \$200,000 Nutrien Classic Campdraft if all the following conditions are complied with:
 - The horse was purchased at a previous Nutrien Classic Sale, Nutrien Graduate Sale or Willinga "Breed for the Future" Filly Sale and remains owned by the original purchaser.
 - The horse is 5 years old or under at the date of the Nutrien Classic Campdraft. (NOTE: All horses will be aged based on the 1st August each year).
 - A horse can be entered in multiple Nutrien Classic Campdraft's whilst they are 5 years of age or under, but if they win any Nutrien Classic Campdraft, they become ineligible to compete in future Nutrien Classic Campdraft's.
 - No horse is eligible to compete in the Nutrien Classic Campdraft if it was sold at the Nutrien Classic Sale by the vendor to a purchaser that is related to the vendor either by syndicate, company, or immediate family.

MARTINS STOCK HAULAGE OPEN CAMPDRAFT TERMS & CONDITIONS - \$330.00

1. Each vendor/purchaser from the previous Nutrien Classic or Masters Sales is limited to two entries in the Martins Stock Haulage Open Campdraft.
2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
3. The Martins Stock Haulage Open Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained by accessing links on the Nutrien Equine website.
4. Entries must be completed by owners wishing to enter horses in the Martins Stock Haulage Open Campdraft.
5. Horses and owners will only be eligible for the Martins Stock Haulage Open Campdraft if they were either vendors or purchasers at the previous Nutrien Classic or Masters Sale.
6. This vendor or purchaser entity is then entitled to enter a maximum of two horses, either of Novice or Open status, to compete in the Martins Stock Haulage Open Campdraft. These horses must be solely owned by the entity that qualified as a vendor or purchaser at the previous year Nutrien Classic Sale or Nutrien Masters Sale.
7. A rider can ride any eligible horse; however, a rider is limited to a maximum of two first round runs in the Martins Stock Haulage Open Campdraft.
8. An eligible horse may be changed up until the start of the competition, providing the new horse meets the qualifying requirements for the Campdraft.

2024 NUTRIEN CLASSIC

PRYDE'S EASIFEED AUSTRALIAN PERFORMANCE HORSE CHALLENGE - \$440.00

1. The challenge will run over two full rounds with a final.
2. Round 1 will be a pre advertised dry working pattern that will take place in the AELEC indoor arena.
3. Round 2 will be a pre advertised indoor working cow event.
4. All finalists will then complete the dry work & immediately follow on and complete their cow work section in draw order allowing each competitor to complete both finals patterns in a finals event. The patterns for the final will be the same as the rounds.
5. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
6. Entry is open to any horse that remains five (5) years or younger at the time of the competition. (NOTE: All horses will be aged based on the 1st August each year).
7. Horses must remain in the ownership of the entity that purchased the horse from a previous Nutrien Classic Sale, Nutrien Graduate Sale or Willinga "Breed for the Future" Filly Sale. Change of ownership will disqualify horses from being eligible for the event.
8. Horses may be ridden by any nominated rider, with the same rider to compete in all rounds of the competition.
9. Full details of the competition including patterns will be available on our website.
10. **Tamworth Council Gelding Incentive**
 - At the completion of event, geldings with the top 3 scores will be presented the gelding incentives awards. Qualifying geldings must appear in their relevant Society studbook as a gelding prior to the event commencement.

11. Metallic Storm Young Guns Incentive

- Open to competitors aged 15 & under 25 years at the day of competition:
 - Competitors aged under 21 years old must have either sold or purchased a horse in their own name at the previous year's Nutrien Classic or Graduate Sale, or their parents have sold/purchased a horse at the previous year's Nutrien Classic or Graduate Sale.
 - Competitors aged 21 & under 25 years must have either sold or purchased a horse in their own right at the previous year's Nutrien Classic Sale.
- A Young Gun will remain eligible for the competition while ever the purchased horse remains eligible.
- At the completion of the first two rounds, the top 5 scoring Young Gun competitors will be taken through to the challenge final.
- The top 3 scoring Young Guns will be awarded places.

4CYTE CHARLIE MAHER MEMORIAL YOUNG GUNS CAMPDRAFT TERMS & CONDITIONS - \$220.00

1. The 4Cyte Charlie Maher Memorial Young Guns Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained by accessing links on the Nutrien Equine website.
2. Open to competitors aged 15 & under 25 years at the day of competition:
 - Competitors aged under 21 years old must have either sold or purchased a horse in their own name at the previous year's Nutrien Classic or Graduate Sale, or their parents have sold/purchased a horse at the previous year's Nutrien Classic or Graduate Sale.
 - Competitors aged 21 & under 25 years must have either sold or purchase a horse in their own right at the previous year's Nutrien Classic Sale.
 - A Young Gun will remain eligible for the competition while ever the purchased horse remains eligible.
3. These competitors can have up to two runs, competing on horses that are qualified & competing in one of the other Campdraft events. Therefore, a horse entered in the Classic or Open competition. These horses do not need to be owned by the competitor or their family, with a horse only allowed to be entered once in the competition.
4. The draft will be run over one rounds and a final.

DALGETY ANIMAL HEALTH STALLION SHOOTOUT TERMS & CONDITONS - \$550.00

1. Stallions must have progeny in the current Nutrien Classic Sale.
2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
3. Stallions must have qualified and competed in the current Martins Stock Haulage Open Campdraft.
4. The competition will run over three rounds as follows:
5. Round 1- Outdoor one round Campdraft (1 Judge)
6. Round 2- Outdoor one round Campdraft (1 Judge)
7. Round 3- Indoor Cut-out. (2 Judges)
8. All three rounds of the Dalgety Stallion Shootout will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained by accessing links on the Nutrien Equine website.

Nutrien Classic Gelding Incentive Campdraft

1. The Nutrien Classic Gelding Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained by accessing links on the Nutrien Equine website.
2. The top 15 geldings aggregate scores from the first two rounds of the Nutrien Classic Campdraft will be invited to compete in a Gelding final of which all competitors will start on a clean slate.
3. Qualifying geldings must appear in their relevant Society studbook as a gelding prior to the event commencement.

Ladies Dash for Cash

1. The Ladies Dash for Cash Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained by accessing links on the Nutrien Equine website.
2. The top 15 (approximately) Lady riders scores across each of Nutrien Classic Campdraft, 4Cyte Charlie Maher Young Guns, Dalgety Stallion Shootout and Martin Stock Haulage Open Campdraft will be invited into a clean slate Dash for Cash final.
