BLACK TRUCK SALES NOVICE CAMPDRAFT

Total prize pool: \$10,000

(2024 ENTRY FEE \$230 INCLUDING GST)

1st May 2024 - 4th May 2024

- 1. The Black Truck Sales Novice Campdraft will be conducted under National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained from Nutrien Ag Solutions, Toowoomba.
- 2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
- 3. Horses are not eligible if they are not transferred into the purchaser's name.
- 4. Entries must be completed by registered owners wishing to enter horses in the Black Truck Sales Novice Campdraft.
- 5. Purchasers and vendors from any previous Nutrien Supreme Sales are entitled to nominate up to four (4) runs per family.

- 2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
- 3. Entries must be completed by registered owners wishing to enter horses in the Shanahan's Livestock Transport Open Campdraft.
- 4. Each vendor/purchaser from any previous Nutrien Supreme Sale are entitled to nominate up to four (4) runs per family in the Shanahan's Livestock Transport Open Campdraft.

The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained from Nutrien Ag Solutions, Toowoomba.
- 2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
- 3. Horses are not eligible if they are not transferred into the purchaser's name.
- 4. Entries must be completed by registered owners wishing to enter horses in the Rosevale Santa Gertrudis 5&U Challenge.
- 5. Nominations are open to any horse and rider. Registration papers or a signed report from registered veterinarian must be presented to verify age.
- 6. The Rosevale Santa Gertrudis 5&U Challenge will include both "dry" and "wet" work. Details of working patterns will be made available prior to the 2024 event. RIVERINA SUPREME 5&U CAMPDRAFT

Total prize pool: \$12,000

(2024 ENTRY FEE: FREE)

1st May 2024 - 4th May 2024

- 1. The Riverina Supreme 5&U Campdraft will be conducted under the National Campdraft Council of Australia (NCCA) rules and regulations with an indemnity waiver to be signed prior to competing. The NCCA rules and regulations and the indemnity waiver can be obtained from Nutrien Ag Solutions, Toowoomba.
- 2. Riders must be at least 15 years of age on the day to compete.
- 3. Horses are not eligible if they are not transferred into the purchaser's name.
- 4. Entries must be completed by registered owners wishing to enter horses in the Riverina Supreme 5&U Campdraft.
- 5. Horses and owners will only be eligible for the prize money that attaches to the Riverina Supreme 5&U Campdraft if all the following conditions are complied with:
 - The horse is aged 5 years or under at the time of the running of the event. (NOTE: All horses will be aged based on the 1st August each year).

- The horse was purchased at a previous Nutrien Supreme Sale (as a ridden horse) and remains owned by the original purchaser. Transfer of ownership must have been completed from original vendor to the successful buyer.

- Lot number and year purchased must be supplied on entry.

- A horse can be entered in multiple Riverina Supreme 5&U Campdraft whilst they are under the age of 5, but if they win any Riverina Supreme 5&U Campdraft, they become include to compete in this event in the future.

- Horses purchased as a yearling at the Nutrien Supreme Sale held in 2021 or later are eligible to enter the Supreme 5 & Under Campdraft until they reach 5 years of age - All Nutrien Campdrafts will be horse status altering in line with NCCA Campdraft Rules.

- Horses and owners will only be eligible for the prize money that attaches to the Dalgety Animal Health 2 Year Old Challenge if all the following conditions are complied with:
 The horse was purchased at the 2023 Nutrien Supreme Sale as a yearling, and remains owned by the original purchaser. Transfer of ownership must have been
 - completed from 2023 vendor to the successful buyer. The lot number and year purchased must be supplied on entry.
 - The horse must be aged 36 months or less on the first day of competition.
 - \$2,000 (10% of total prize pool) will be awarded to the original vendor who sold the 2024 Dalgety Animal Health 2 Year Old Challenge Champion at the 2023 sale (yearling).
